### A cash boost for tyre plant

SP TYRES is preparing to pump more than £3 mil-lion into its Birmingham factory, it was revealed

The investment, in the latest equipment for handling raw materials coming into the giant Fort Dunlop plant, is due to start before the end of the year.

And it will take the total invested past £100m since the firm was formed in 1984.
