New Amstrad man resigns

MOUNTING losses at computers and sat-ellite dishes company Amstrad have forced the finance director, Mr Peter Thoms, to resign.

He was the second director to leave ty-coon Alan Sugar's troubled empire in three days after corporate finance director Ken Ashcroft quit.

Amstrad expects to make a loss of £65 million in the year to the end of June — £25 million more than was predicted. The company blamed savage price cut-ting for its problems.
