

Mr. Henry Alliband late of 59 Speley Street Redditch in the County of Worcester Fish-hook Maker died intestate on the 29th day of January 1906 and Letters of Administration of his Estate were on the 21st day of February 1906 granted to his son George Alliband out of the Principal Probate Registry.
