This is the last Will and Testament

of me Mary of Alcester
Road Studley in the County of Warwick.

I hereby revoke all Wills by me at any time heretofore made. I appoint my son Albert Edward The bedars, Studley to be my Executor and I direct that all my just debts and Funeral and Testamentary expenses shall be paid as soon as possible after my decease.

I hereby give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Louisa the whole of my jewelry plate and wearing apparel absolutely, and unto my husband Jabez Bartlam the interest of all my estate which I desire to be sold as soon as possible after my decease, and all proceeds from the said sale to be invested as my aforesaid Executor may desire when the aforesaid debts and expenses be paid, And upon the death of my husband the whole of the said estate to be divided as hereinafter mentioned.

My daughter Mary Louisa one-fourth, and the remaining three-fourths to be equally divided as follows between my sons Albert Edward, Thomas Henry, George Weaver and Lavinia Weaver being my daughter by adoption

If any of the aforesaid mentioned be then deceased there portions to go to there children if any and if no children the said parts to be equally divided among my said sons & daughters then living.
