 my last Will I appoint my three grandchildren
 John Booker Riches George Riches and
 Mabel Riches (hereinafter called "my Trustees")
 to be the Executors and Executrix and
 Trustees of my Will I bequeath to my
 late housekeeper Mrs. Diston of Abchurch in
 the said County Widow (nee Miss Davies) the
 sum of twenty five pounds free of duty I
 devise and bequeath all my real and
 personal estate not hereby otherwise disposed of
 unto my Trustees Upon Trust that my Trustees
 shall sell call in and convert into money the
 same or such part thereof as shall not consist
 of money and shall out of the moneys
 produced by such sale calling in and conversion
