Willis is the last Will and Testament ^{of me}

George Bull of Willshire Road Reddish in the County of Mereseth Welle
do hereby appoint my son George Frederick Bull and my wife - son
William Edwin Henry to be the executors and trustees of this my will
I give Kate Elizabeth Smead and Sadie Math and chain and Stence Practice Coors
Shane and Selby Glass to George Frederick Bull my Watch and chain also contents of
Brauers to Emma Jane Lewis Tea Pot, Sylvia Lurman Braimond Ring William
Edwin Avery Bracelet and Read Knife and Fork I give deisel and beneath
the residue of my real and personal property whatever and wheresoever unto my
Trustees Upon trust that they shall sell call in and convert the same into
money and shall with and out of the proceeds of sale in the first place pay
my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and shall invest the residue of
such monies with power for my Trustees from time to time to allow such
investments And I direct my Trustees to stand possessed of the said proceeds of
sale and the investments for the time being representing the same (hereinafter
called "the residuary trust monies") and the income thereof In trust to pay
and apply the same both as regards capital and income for the maintenance
and support of my wife Elizabeth Bull during her life as in their absolute
discretion they shall think fit And after the decease of my said wife In

trust to pay and divide any residue which may remain of my said estate
equally between my step-son the said William Edwin Avery my step-daughter Kate
Elizabeth Swickard and my children Emma Jane Lewis the said George Frederick
Roll Sylvia Linnam and Florence Beatrice Evans. And in case either of my said
step-children or children shall die in my lifetime leaving issue I direct that
the share of the one so dying shall be paid to such issue. Provided always
and I hereby authorize my trustees to continue to carry on my business of a
seller of securities for such time as they shall think fit and in such manner
as they shall think proper with power for my trustees to use the whole or
any part of my assets for the purchase of or carrying on such business. And
I also declare that all monies liable to be inserted under this my will
may be invested in any stocks funds or securities authorized by law for trust
funds or in the purchase of or ground rents or annuities out of freehold or leasehold
property in England or Wales or in the purchase of freehold or leasehold
property situate in England or Wales or in mortgage of any leasehold premises
or land in England or Wales held for any term having at least sixty years
to run at the time of investment. *In witness whereof* I have set my hand
to this my will this eighteenth day of August one thousand nine hundred and
two. The mark X of George Roll _____ signed by the said George
