Chesshire the Son of deceased the Executors



Elizabeth wife of Robert Arthur Roberts one feather bed
bolster pillow and mattress One of my best white
damask table cloths one workbox and one tea chest
I bequeath to my daughter Sophia Cheshire
Spinster one feather bed bolster pillow and mattress
six silver tea spoons and pair sugar tongs one workbox
✓ one tea chest and one of my best white damask table
cloths I bequeath to my daughter Henrietta wife of
Thomas Free my little French clock one work box one tea
chest and one embroidered fire screen I bequeath to my
said three daughters Mary Elizabeth Roberts, Sophia
Cheshire and Henrietta Free all counterpanes blankets
household linen (including my clothing) and all jewelry
pictures and books (except such as are heretofore and
hereinafter specifically bequeathed) and I direct that the
✓ same shall be divided between them in equal shares
as tenants in common I bequeath to my son Horatio
Howard Cheshire one feather bed bolster and pillow and
the large pair of pictures of Torgrave House now in
my possession I bequeath to my son William
Henry Cheshire one feather bed bolster and pillow I
bequeath to my son Arthur Barnabas Cheshire my

large handsome mahogany clock and weather glass
I bequeath to my son Harvey Ambrose Chesshire
the case of birds now in my possession and the
✓ long silver chain which formally belonged to his late
father I direct that all and singular the residue
and remainder of my household goods furniture and
effects not hereinbefore specifically bequeathed shall be sold
by auction as soon as conveniently may be after my
decease and the net proceeds thereof together with all
monies I may have standing to my credit at my
decease at the Redditch Branch of the Capital and Counties
Bank and in the Post Office Savings Bank and also all
✓ other monies which I may die possessed of or entitled to
after payment thereof of my just debts and my funeral
and testamentary charges and expenses shall be divided
between and amongst my said children following
namely Mary Elizabeth Roberts Sophia Chesshire Henrietta
Freo Horatio Howard Chesshire William Henry Chesshire
Arthur Barnabas Chesshire and Harvey Ambrose Chesshire
in equal shares as tenants in common to whom I
bequeath the same accordingly subject to the said Arthur
Barnabas Chesshire's share being ten pounds less than
the respective shares of the others in consequence of my
✓ having left him the clock at Torquay House and I
further direct that the respective shares of such of my
children as are daughters shall be paid to them absolutely
And I further direct that if either of my said
children shall die without leaving lawful issue the share

or shares of her him or them so dying shall go to
 and be divided amongst the survivor or survivors of them
 in equal shares as tenants in common And I lastly
 ✓ direct that if any or either of my said children shall
 die in my lifetime leaving lawful issue such issue
 shall take such deceased^{ly} parents share and if there
 shall be more than one then such issue shall take
 equally as tenants in common the share of such
 grandchild being a female to be received by her absolutely
 I appoint my said daughter Henrietta Tree and
 my son Harvey Ambrose Cheshire Executrix and
 Executor of this my said last Will and Testament
 hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time
 heretofore made In witness whereof I have
