of me


Joseph Cornwell of Bradley Green in the parish of Teckenham in the county of Worcester Needle Finisher I appoint my wife Elizabeth Cornwell and Hubert Walker Webb Gould of Teckenham aforesaid Machinist if and when he shall attain the age of twenty one years (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I bequeath the use and enjoyment of all my household furniture and all other articles of personal domestic or household use or ornament to my wife during her life And I declare that after her death the same shall fall into my residuary estate I bequeath to the said Hubert Walker Webb Gould if he shall prove my Will the sum of five pounds as an acknowledgment for his trouble in executing the office of Trustee and Executor of my Will I devise and bequeath all the residue of my estate and effects whether real or personal unto my Trustees Upon trust that my Trustees or the survivor of them or other the Trustees for the time being of this my Will shall sell call in collect and convert into money the said real and personal estate and premises at such time or times and in such manner as they shall think fit

And shall out of the moneys to arise from such sale calling in collection and conversion pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and the aforesaid legacy And shall invest the residue of the said moneys with power for my Trustees from time to time at their discretion to vary such investments And shall stand possessed of the said residuary trust moneys and the investments for the time being representing the same In trust to pay the income thereof to my said wife during her life and after her decease In trust for my daughter Cordia Ann Moleworth the wife of Henry Moleworth of Bradley Green aforesaid Wheelwright and Thomas Pace of Bookhill Machine needle Maker in equal shares **In witness** whereof I have hereunto set my hand this fourth day of December one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven \_\_\_\_\_ Joseph Cornwell
