of me

William Henry Elvins of Redditch in the county of Worcester Builder I appoint Howard Charles Perry of number 206 Mount Pleasant Redditch aforesaid carpenter and Arthur Elvins of number 29 Everley Road Small Heath Birmingham in the county of Warwick Engine Driver (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will And I give to each of my Trustees the sum of five pounds for his trouble in acting as such Executor and Trustee I devise all my real estate whatsoever and wheresoever To the use of my Mother Harriet Elvins during her life and after her death To the use of my Father John Elvins during his life And after the death of both of them the said Harriet Elvins and John Elvins To the use of my Trustees Upon trust to sell the same and to stand possessed of the proceeds of such sale upon the same trusts in favour of my Brothers and Sisters and their children as are hereinafter declared in respect of my residuary personal estate and the income thereof after the death of my said Mother and Father I bequeath all my personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto and to the use of my Trustees Upon trust that my Trustees shall sell call in and convert into money

the same or such part thereof as shall not consist
of money and shall with and out of the moneys
produced by such sale and conversion and with and
out of my ready money pay my funeral and
testamentary expenses debts and legacies And shall
invest the residue of the said moneys in any
stocks funds or securities for the time being
authorised by law for trust money with power
for my Trustees from time to time at their
discretion to vary the investments And shall
stand possessed of the residue of the said
moneys and the investments for the time being
representing the same Upon trust to pay the
income thereof to my said Mother Harriet Elvins
during her life And from and after her death
Upon trust to pay the income thereof to my
said Father John Elvins during his life and
after the death of both of them my said Father
and Mother In trust for all or any my
Brothers and Sisters living at my death and the
children or child then living of any then deceased
Brother or Sister of mine who being male attain
the age of twenty one years or being female
attain that age or marry in equal shares but
so that the children of any deceased Brother or
Sister if more than one shall take equally
between them only the share which their parent
would have taken if he or she had lived
