This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.

This is the last Will and Testament

of me

Francis Forster of Gilbert's Green in the parish of Janworth in the County of Warwick retired Farmer I hereby revoke all former testamentary dispositions made by me I appoint my nephews William Forster and Fred Forster (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of my Will I bequeath to each of my Trustees the sum of three guineas I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my Trustees Upon trust that my Trustees shall sell call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and shall out of the moneys produced by such sale calling in and conversion and out of my ready money pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and legacies And shall divide the residue of the said moneys unto and equally between my nephews and nieces living at my decease and the children or child then living of any then deceased nephew or niece but so that the children or child of any deceased nephew or niece of mine shall take and if more than one equally between them as tenants in common only the share which their parent would have taken

had he or she survived me and attained a vested interest. And I declare that Thomas Henry Shore the child of my deceased niece Maria Shore shall take the share of the said moneys which his Mother would have taken had she been living at the time of my death. **In witness** whereof I have set my hand to this my Will this thirty-first day of October One thousand nine hundred and ten _____ The mark of X Francis Forster _____ Signed by the above-named Francis Forster as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us both being present at the same time who in his presence at his request and in the presence of each other have herunto subscribed our names as witnesses (the same having been first read over to him in our presence) the interlineations between the eighth and ninth seventeenth and eighteenth twentieth and twenty-first twenty-second and twenty-third and twenty-third and twenty-fourth lines of the previous page having been first made _____ Thos J.
