This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.

This is the last Will and Testament



James Forster of Perry Mill Farm Beoley in the County of Worcester Farmer I appoint my cousins Fred Forster and Hubert Forster (hereinafter called my Trustees) to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I bequeath to my Trustees the sum of three hundred pounds (free of legacy duty) Upon trust to spend the sum of two hundred pounds part thereof in repairing and improving Perry Mill Farm and premises and to spend the remaining sum of one hundred pounds in the purchase of cattle and farming stock to be used or run on the said Farm I devise my said farm called Perry Mill Farm and the lands and premises belonging thereto and the furniture and household effects in or upon the said farm and farming stock unto my Trustees Upon trust for my cousin Maria Forster during her life And upon her decease Upon trust to sell the same and to stand possessed of the net proceeds of such sale upon the same trusts as are ^{hereinafter} ~~herebefore~~ declared in respect of my residuary estate I bequeath the sum of One hundred pounds to my Trustees Upon trust to pay thereout to my brother Charles Forster the sum of twenty pounds per annum the said sum of one hundred pounds

to be free of legacy duty I give to my Trustees
the sum of five pounds each for their trouble
respectively I give devise and bequeath all
the residue of my estate (both real and personal)
to my Trustees Upon trust to sell call in and
convert into money the same or such part thereof
as shall not consist of ready money and with and
out of the moneys to arise from such sale calling
in and conversion and with and out of my ready
money to pay my funeral and testamentary expenses
debts and legacies and legacy duty And to stand
possessed of the residue of the said moneys In
trust for my brothers and sister and the child
or children of any deceased brothers or sister of mine
who being male have attained or shall attain
the age of 21 years or being female have attained
or shall attain that age or marry and if more
than one in equal shares but so that the child
or children of any deceased brother or sister of
mine shall take equally between them if more
than one the share only which a brother or
sister of mine would have taken had he or she
survived me and attained a vested interest **In**
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
this first day of May one thousand nine hundred
and eighteen.
