This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.



THE CONDITIONS STATED IN THE ANNEXED MEMORANDUM.

PROBATE.

This is the last Will and Testament of me


Mary Goodman of Unicorn Hill Redditch in the County of Worcester Spinster I revoke all Wills codicils and testamentary instruments heretofore made by me I appoint my friends Alfred Hughes of The North Western Arcade in the City of Birmingham Restaurant Proprietor and Frederick William Hollington of Bromsgrove Road Redditch aforesaid Draper (hereinafter called "my Trustees") Executors and Trustees of this my Will I direct that a headstone shall be erected to my memory by my Trustees over my grave I bequeath the following legacies namely To Jane Husband a servant in the employ of the said Frederick William Hollington the sum of fifty pounds free of legacy duty To the persons hereinafter mentioned now in the employ of the said Alfred Hughes at The North Western Arcade Birmingham aforesaid (namely) To Lilly Potter the sum of ten pounds To Dora Rowe the sum of five pounds To Miss King (engaged in the Smoke Room) the sum of five pounds To John Lovell the sum of three pounds and To Fanny Lloyd the sum of two pounds which said legacies I also bequeath free

of legacy duty To Elizabeth Goodman (widow of my half brother John Goodman) the sum of twenty pounds free of legacy duty To Elizabeth Hollington (wife of the said Frederick William Hollington) the sum of one hundred pounds To Sarah Jane Deville of Unicorn Hill Redditch aforesaid Spinster the sum of three hundred pounds and To the said Alfred Hughes the sum of one hundred pounds I bequeath the following charitable legacies that is to say To the Trustees of the Congregational Schools at Redditch aforesaid the sum of ten pounds To the Trustees of the Congregational Chapel at Redditch aforesaid for the benefit of the Christian Endeavour Society held there the sum of five pounds and To the like Trustees for the benefit of the Renovation Fund of the said Chapel the sum of ten pounds And I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of the same respective societies and institutions shall be a sufficient discharge for the same respective legacies Whereas in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight I advanced and lent to the said Alfred Hughes the sum of four hundred pounds and he paid me interest thereon after the rate of ten pounds per centum per annum up to the year one thousand nine hundred and fifteen and since then at interest after the rate of six

pounds per centum per annum Now I consider that any interest over and above the rate of five pounds per centum per annum on the said principal sum of four hundred pounds which I received from the said Alfred Hughes was a debt owing by me to him and I release and forgive to him or to his representatives if he should die in my lifetime the said sum of four hundred pounds now due to me from him as aforesaid or so much thereof as shall remain owing to me at my death after deducting therefrom the interest I shall have received over and above the rate of five pounds per centum per annum as aforesaid the amount of which I also forgive him if and so far as the same shall not be in the nature of a debt due from me to him but nevertheless the total amount of the two sums shall not exceed four hundred pounds And I direct that every bond bill note or other security for the said principal sum shall be released and given up to the said Alfred Hughes or his representatives And whereas in the year one thousand nine hundred and six I advanced and lent to the said Frederick William Hollington the sum of four hundred pounds and he paid me interest thereon after the rate of eight pounds per centum per annum up to the year one thousand nine

hundred and fifteen and since then at interest
after the rate of five pounds per centum per
annum Now I also consider that any interest
over and above the rate of five pounds per
centum per annum on the said principal sum
of four hundred pounds which I received from
the said Frederick William Hollington was a
debt owing by me to him and I release and
forgive to him or to his representatives if he
should die in my lifetime the said sum of four
hundred pounds now due to me from him as
aforesaid or so much thereof as shall remain
owing to me at my death after deducting there-
from the interest I shall have received over and
above the rate of five pounds per centum per
annum as aforesaid the amount of which I also
forgive him if and so far as the same shall
not be in the nature of a debt due from me
to him but nevertheless the total amount of the
two sums shall not exceed four hundred
pounds And I direct that every bond bill note
or other security for the said principal sum
shall be released and given up to the said
Frederick William Hollington or his representatives
I devise and bequeath all my real estate
of every tenure and all my personal estate and
effects whatsoever and wheresoever not hereby other-
wise disposed of (including as well real as #

personal estate over which I may have any
 general power of appointment or disposition by
 Will) unto and to the use of my Trustees their
 heirs executors and administrators respectively accord-
 -ing to the nature thereof Upon trust that my
 Trustees shall sell call in collect and convert
 into money the said real and personal estate and
 premises And shall out of the moneys to arise
 from such sale calling in and conversion and
 ✓ out of my ready money pay my funeral and
 testamentary expenses and debts and the legacies
 bequeathed by this my Will or any codicil
 hereto and the duty on any legacies bequeathed
 free of duty and make provision for the erection
 of a headstone over my grave as hereinbefore
 directed And shall stand possessed of the
 residue of the said moneys In trust as to
 fifty pounds for the said Elizabeth Hollington
 in addition to the legacy of one hundred
 ✓ pounds hereinbefore bequeathed to her and as
 to the remainder (if any) for the said Alfred
 Hughes and Frederick William Hollington in
 equal shares absolutely Provided always and
 I declare that if the moneys to arise from
 the sale and conversion hereby directed or other-
 -wise forming part of my estate shall not be
 sufficient to pay my funeral and testamentary
 expenses and debts and cost of headstone and




all the legacies hereby bequeathed and the

shall abate proportionately **In witness** whereof
