THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

of me John
 Hemmings of Shudley in the County of Warwick Bachelor and Grocer I direct first
 the payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses and subject thereto
 I give devise and bequeath all my household furniture and real property of which I
 may die possessed to my wife Elizabeth Hemmings for and during her natural
 life if she shall so long remain my widow and after her death or second marriage
 I direct my two houses at Nickepot to my eldest son Joseph John Hemmings and his
 heirs absolutely and my one house at Shudley in the County of Warwick to my
 younger son William Henry Hemmings in like manner I also direct that as to my
 trade or business of a Grocer and Grocer now carried on by me at Shudley aforesaid
 in partnership with my said son my wife shall have the option of receiving ^{the sum of} five
 shillings a week out of the profits of the same for her natural life or until her second
 marriage as aforesaid or she shall if she shall elect and desire to do so receive and
 take from my said son as my partners as aforesaid a sum which shall be equivalent
 to an annuity of five shillings a week to her for life to be paid as she shall direct
 and all the real residue and remainder of the real or personal estate
 whatsoever of which I may die possessed I give devise and bequeath the same
 to my said wife her heirs executors administrators and assigns I hereby appoint
 my said wife the sole executrix of this my will and declare that in case she
