

 if he shall prove this my Will and accept the trusts
 thereof I give devise and bequeath All my real and
 personal estate Unto the said Charles Savage his heirs
 executors and administrators Upon Trust to sell the
 same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money
 and with and out of the moneys produced by such
 sale and conversion and with and out of my ready
 money to pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and
 debts and to retain the aforesaid Legacy to him and to
 stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys In
 trust for all or any my nephews and nieces and the
 children then living of any then deceased nephew or ~
 niece of mine who being male attain or have attained
 the age of twenty one years or being female have ~
 attained or shall attain that age or marry in equal
 shares as tenants in common but so that the children
 of any deceased nephew or niece if more than one
 shall take equally between them only the share which
 their parent would have taken if surviving me and ~
 attaining the age of twenty one years I appoint the



said Charles Savage sole executor of this my will
In Witness whereof I the said Betsy Heritage have
to this my will set my hand this twenty second day
of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty six.
