Ellen Emily Hickley of Saint Mary's Oswald Road Leamington in the county of Warwick Widow I appoint my Brother Thomas Edward Webb, my sister Emma Jane Brannore and my friend Frederick William Hollington of Redditch in the county of Worcester Draper (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I give my gold watch and chain to my niece Gertrude Webb I give my diamond ring and also all my wearing apparel to my said sister Emma Jane Brannore I bequeath the remainder of my personal ornaments and also my plate linen china pictures and any other articles of domestic use or ornament belonging to me at the time of my death unto my Trustees Upon trust to permit my said sister Emma Jane Brannore to use and enjoy the same or during her life And after her death Upon trust to divide the same as fairly in their discretion as they reasonably can between the daughters of my said brother Thomas Edward Webb And I declare that my Trustees shall not be personally responsible for the preservation of the said last mentioned effects but they shall

make a list thereof immediately after my death before delivering the said effects to my said sister

I bequeath to my said brother Thomas Edward Webb the sum of three hundred pounds absolutely

I bequeath to my said sister Emma Jane Cranmore the sum of One hundred pounds absolutely

I bequeath to each of my nieces Clara Webb, Gertrude Webb and Nora Webb (the three daughters

of my said brother Thomas Edward Webb) the sum of One hundred pounds absolutely

And if any of them shall die in my lifetime then I bequeath the said sum of One hundred pounds which

any such deceased niece would have been entitled to if she had survived me unto the sons or

son then living of my said brother Thomas Edward Webb and if more than one in equal

shares I bequeath to my niece Lilian Mary Webb the daughter of my deceased brother William


Webb the sum of One hundred pounds absolutely I bequeath to Clara Alderton the daughter of

my sister-in-law Charlotte Ann Alderton the sum of One hundred pounds absolutely I

bequeath to each of the sons of my said brother Thomas Edward Webb the sum of twenty

pounds absolutely I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever and

wheresoever (except what I otherwise dispose of by this my Will or any codicil hereto) unto my



Trustees Upon Trust that my Trustees shall sell
 call in and convert into money the same or
 such part thereof as shall not consist of money
 and shall out of the proceeds of such sale
 calling in and conversion and with and out of
 my ready money pay my funeral and
 testamentary expenses and debts and the legacies
 (other than specific) bequeathed by this my Will
 or any bodical hereto And shall stand
 possessed of the residue of the said moneys
 In trust for and to pay the same to my
 said brother Thomas Edward Webb absolutely

 Kinswood Avenue, Leamington wish to add a
 bodical to my Will to the effect that on account

of my brother's & sister's age I desire my niece
Gertrude Maud Webb & my nephew Edgar
B. Webb to stand as executress & executor in place
of my brother Thomas Edward Webb & my sister
E. J. Brammore as mentioned in my Will.

Instead of my brother J. E. Webb receiving the
residue from my estate I wish that he & his
wife Catherine Webb should receive the income
therefrom during their lifetimes & at their death

the capital from which this income is derived
to be equally divided among their children.

I bequeath to my niece Gertrude Maud Webb
the sum of £200 instead of £100 as before
mentioned, also a portion of the household linen,
especially that which she has worked, & any
other that she may select.

I bequeath all
my wearing apparel my personal ornaments,
my plate china & pictures & any other articles
of domestic use or ornaments to my niece
Gertrude M. Webb absolutely. I give my diamond
ring, as previously mentioned in my Will as being

left to my sister to my nephew & godson John
Timms Webb. The sum of £100 lent to my
sister's step-daughter Eliza Brammore I give absolutely
to my said sister Emma Jane Brammore, also my
sable necklet during her lifetime, & then to my
niece G. M. Webb.
