# This is the Last Will and Testament

of me

Samuel Hill of 1 Oswald Street in that part of Redditch which is in the County of Warwick Machinist I hereby revoke all Wills by me at any time heretofore made I appoint Philip Spencer of Redditch aforesaid Surgical Needle Manufacturer and Thomas Jeromes of Coleshill in the County of Warwick Engineer (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of my Will I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate unto my Trustees Upon Trust that my Trustees shall sell call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and shall out of the moneys produced by such sale calling in and conversion and out of my ready money pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts And shall stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys In Trust for my step-daughter Emma Spencer, my nieces Mary Ann Jeromes and Margaret Sophia Plesters my nephew Samuel James Plesters and my late wife's nephews John Facey and Thomas Facey in equal shares But if the said John Facey and Thomas Facey shall not within one year after my death



claim their respective shares under this my will  
then my Trustees shall deposit such shares or  
share in the Capital and Counties Bank at  
Redditch in the names of my Trustees and shall  
thereupon properly advertize in the Daily Mail  
Newspaper for any information concerning them  
or their whereabouts respectively as the case may  
be (the cost to be borne by such shares) but if  
at the end of two years after my death both  
or either of them the said John Jacey and  
Thomas Jacey shall not be found then the  
shares or share they or he would have taken  
in my Estate shall be divided equally between
