Albert Morriss of Smallwoods Row Redditch in the County of Worcester Needle Polisher I appoint my brother Alfred Morriss and my friend Linemore Spencer of Redditch of the County of Worcester (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate unto my Trustees Upon trust that they shall sell call in and collect the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of ready money And shall out of the monies arising thereby and all other monies forming part of my estate pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts And shall invest the residue of the said monies in any of the investments for the time being authorized by law for the investment of trust monies and may vary such investments at discretion And shall pay the income of the said residuary monies and investments to my said wife during her life if she shall so long remain my widow And after her decease or second marriage (which shall first happen) shall hold the same and the income thereof In trust for all my

children or any my child who being sons or a son  
attain the age of twenty one years or being daughters or a  
daughter attain that age or many and if more than one  
in equal shares *My wife's* whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand this twenty fifth day of October
