in the "Redditch Building Society" and the "General Post Office Savings Bank" or otherwise to be equally divided between my brother William my sisters Kate Anne and Sarah; and to be as divided within three months after my decease. The

interest from my eleven shares in the "Great Worcestershire Waterworks Company" to be paid to my father Thomas Oakley during his life; and at his death the said
