Thomas Oakley of "Stamwood" number 18 Park Road Redditch in the County of
 Worcester Needle and Sewing Machine Manufacturers hereby make all former
 Wills and testamentary dispositions made by me I appoint my daughters Kate
 Scott and Elizabeth Mary Oakley and my son Thomas William Price
 Oakley (hereafter called "my trustees") to be the executors and overseers
 and trustees of this my will I bequeath unto my daughter the said Elizabeth
 Oakley such articles of furniture beds bedclothes bedding and other household
 effects as she shall within one calendar month after my death select to the value
 of thirty pounds for her own use and benefit such value in case of dispute to be
 determined by my trustees in such manner as they shall think proper And
 I declare that my daughter the said Elizabeth Mary Oakley shall be entitled to
 the personal use occupation and enjoyment free from rent rates and taxes for a
 period of one calendar month after my death of my residue amount or any other
 dwellinghouse in which I may reside at my death she keeping the same insured
 against fire but without liability for fire rates and tax I give devise and
 bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever (except what I otherwise
 dispose of by this my will or any other wills) unto my trustees upon
 trust that my trustees shall sell all such in and convert into money the same

on each part thereof as shall not conceal of money And shall with out out
of the moneys produced by such sale calling in and execution and with out out of
my ready moneys pay my funeral and extraordinary expenses and debts And shall
stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys In trust for my five children
hereinafter named (that is to say) the said Kate Lett the said Elizabeth Mary
Cockley Mary Ann Lealey Sarah Jones Will and the said Thomas William Price
