This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.




This is the last Will and Testament

John Job Rea of The Pound in the parish of Bentley Pouncefoot in the county of Worcester Farmer I appoint Ernest Derrice of Rectory Road Redditch in the same county Commercial Traveller (hereinafter called "my Trustee") to be the Executor and Trustee of my Will and I bequeath to him the sum of five pounds as an acknowledgment for his trouble in executing the office of Executor and Trustee of my Will I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my Trustee In trust to convert the same into money by sale or otherwise and to divide the proceeds (after paying my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and retaining the legacy hereby bequeathed) among my children William Rea Henry Rea Joseph Rea and Mary Ann Mason (the wife of Robert Mason) in equal shares In witness whereof I have set my hand to this my Will this second day of December One thousand nine hundred and eleven.

In addition to the provisions of the above mentioned Will and Codicil I have this fourth day of May one thousand nine hundred and sixteen nominated my cousin G. H. Ray of the Dale Farm, Blackwell, Nr. Bromsgrove, to receive the money due on my death from the Police Mutual Assurance Association such money to be expended by him in defraying the expenses of my funeral and the balance devoted to the purchase and erection of a memorial stone to the memory of my late wife and myself in Tardeligg Churchyard, And I further direct my Trustee Ernest Penrice to pay out of my estate a legacy of three pounds to my brother Benjamin Rea of Crosswells, Umberley, And I confirm my said Will and the foregoing Codicil in all respects **In witness** whereof I have herunto set my hand this fourth day of May one thousand nine hundred and sixteen _____ The mark of John Job Rea.
