

Walter Smith of Alcester Street Redditch in the County of Worcester Grocer and Provision Dealer made the twenty seventh day of April one thousand nine hundred and eight I appoint my dear Wife Ann Elizabeth Smith and my son Albert William Smith (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will I direct that my Trustees shall as soon as conveniently may be after my decease pay my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I bequeath to my said Wife the sum of twenty five pounds to be paid to her as soon as may be after my decease for her immediate requirements and I also authorize my said Wife to select out of my plate linen china glass books pictures prints furniture and other household effects such articles as she may desire to have and I give the articles to be so selected by her unto my said Wife absolutely I give and devise all my real and personal estate not hereby otherwise disposed of including the goodwill of my trade or business of a Grocer and Provision Dealer and the stock in trade and effects employed therein or belonging thereto and all book debts and moneys



due to me in respect thereof to my said son
Albert William Smith Provided always and
I declare that the devise and bequest of my said
real and personal estate and the said business &
and premises hereinbefore made to my said son
is so made on this express condition that my
said son shall pay to my said Wife during her
life an annuity of Twenty six pounds per annum
commencing from my death to be payable by
weekly instalments of ten shillings per week -
Provided also and I declare that my said son
his heirs executors and assigns shall within two
calendar months after my death at the expense of
my estate enter into a proper Bond or Covenant
with my said Wife and to her satisfaction for
securing the payment of the Annuity in
manner aforesaid hereby directed to be paid by
him unto or for the benefit of my said Wife I
revoke all former Wills by me at any time
hereto made *In witness* whereof I have to
this my last Will set my hand the day
and year first hereinbefore written.
