in the territory of any State which is at War with His Majesty, without the express sanction of
the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary
to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper
cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of
assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are enemy subjects resident in this country at the
commencement of the War and during the War.
