AND BE IT FURTHER KNOWN that at the date hereunder written the last Will and Testament

This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is an alien enemy, wherever resident, or anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person of whatever nationality, resident in the territory of any State which is at War with His Majesty, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper arrangements being made for the payment of a moderate sum out of the assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are enemy subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.
