hereby revoke all Wills and Testamentary dispositions
heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last
will

- 1 I appoint my Sons Lewis Unitt and William
Unitt (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the
Executors and Trustees of this my will
- 2 I bequeath to my said Son William Unitt
absolutely such of the household furniture and other
household effects as belong to me and are in the dwellinghouse
in Heathfield Road aforesaid wherein I now reside with
my said Son.
- 3 As to all the rest of my estate and effects both real
and personal I devise and bequeath the same unto and to
the use of my Trustees Upon Trust to sell call in and convert
into money my real and residuary personal estate (with
power in their discretion to postpone such sale calling in
and conversion for such a period as to them shall seem
expedient) and with and out of the moneys produced by
such sale calling in and conversion and with and out of
my ready money to pay my funeral and Testamentary
expenses and debts And to stand possessed of the residue of
such moneys (hereinafter called "my residuary estate")
As to one equal eighth part thereof In trust for my
grandson Gerald Unitt Turcer if and when he shall
attain the age of twenty one years And subject thereto
(as to the whole residue of such moneys) In trust for my

children Maria Tomkins, Lewis Unitt, William Unitt
Annie Aray, Arthur Unitt, Samuel Unitt and
Gladys Thompson or such of them as shall survive me in
equal shares as tenants in common

4 Provided always that if any of my said
children shall die in my lifetime leaving issue who
shall survive me and who being male shall attain the
age of twenty one years or being female shall attain that
age or marry under that age such issue shall take
and if more than one equally between them the
share which their father or her parent would have taken
in my residuary estate if such parent had survived me
