Ellen Jane Warner the wife of Joseph Edgar Warner
of "Ipoley" Broad Walk, Stratford-on-Avon, in the County
of Warwick Retired Manufacturer I revoke all testamentary
instruments heretofore executed by me and I appoint my
husband the said Joseph Edgar Warner and William
George Thomas of Redditch in the County of Worcester
Solicitor (who and the survivor of whom and the executors
and administrators of such survivor are hereinafter referred to
as my Trustees) to be the Executors and Trustees of this
my Will I request my Trustees to distribute all articles and
effects which may be specified in any list or memorandum
signed by me and deposited with this my Will or which may
be left by me at my death in accordance with any directions
therein contained but I declare that any such list or
memorandum shall not be deemed to have any testamentary
character or effect by way of creating any trust or otherwise
however. And as to all the rest of my estate and effects
both real and personal I devise and bequeath the same
unto and to the use of my Trustees upon trust to sell call
in and convert into money my real and residuary personal
estate and out of the proceeds thereof to pay my funeral and
testamentary expenses and debts and upon further trust to
invest the residue of the moneys arising from the sale
calling in and conversion of my real and residuary personal
estate in the names or name of my Trustees And to pay

the annual income of such investments to my said husband during his life And from and after his death as to the capital and income of the same investments Upon trust for my four children Percy Howard Warner, Norah Graham Maxwell Lionel Eric Warner and Dorothy Helen Warner in equal shares the respective shares of such children except the said Dorothy Helen Warner to be absolutely vested on my death And I declare that the share of my estate heretofore bequeathed to my said Daughter Dorothy Helen Warner shall not vest absolutely in such daughter but shall be retained by my Trustees upon trust to pay or apply the whole or any part of the income thereof to or for the benefit of the said Dorothy Helen Warner during her life with power to pay the said income or any part thereof to any person or persons for the benefit of the said Dorothy Helen Warner without seeing to the application thereof and after the death of the said Dorothy Helen Warner I direct my trustees to stand possessed of the said share In trust for the child or children of the said Dorothy Helen Warner who shall attain the age of twenty one years if more than one in equal shares And upon the death of the said Dorothy Helen Warner without leaving a child who shall attain the age of twenty one years then In trust for the said Percy Howard Warner Norah Graham Maxwell and Lionel Eric Warner in equal shares Provided that if any of my said children shall die in my lifetime leaving issue who shall survive me and who shall attain the age of twenty one years such issue shall take and if more than one equally between them the share which their his or her parent would have taken of and in my estate if such parent had lived to attain a vested interest And I declare that my trustees may in their absolute

discretion postpone for such period as they think proper the sale calling in and conversion of all or any part of my real or personal estate even though of a wasting speculative or reversionary nature and may apply the whole of the income of property actually producing income as from my death as income And I

also declare that any Trustee of this my will who shall be a Solicitor or engaged in any other profession or business shall be entitled to make all usual professional charges in respect of all work done by him in relation to the trusts hereof in the same manner in all respects as if he were not such trustee
