This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.



# This is the last Will and Testament

<sup>of me</sup>  
 Mary Weaver of "The Hawthorn" Bromsgrove Road  
 Redditch in the County of Worcester Widow I revoke all  
 testamentary writings heretofore executed by me I appoint  
 my daughter Constance Mildred Weaver and my nephew William  
 George Thomas of Redditch aforesaid Soleitor (who and the  
 survivor of whom and the executor or administrators of such  
 survivor are hereinafter referred to as "my Trustees") to be the  
 Executors and Trustees of this my Will I bequeath to my  
 son Arthur Bernard Weaver my gold watch and gold chain  
 and to my said daughter my "Erard" Piano I bequeath all my  
 clothing and wearing apparel to my said daughter to be disposed  
 of as she may think fit I bequeath all my jewellery (except  
 as aforesaid) and the furniture and household effects at "The  
 Hawthorn" aforesaid belonging to me to my said daughter and  
 to my said son in equal shares And I declare that if any  
 dispute shall arise between my said daughter and my said  
 son as to the division of the said jewellery furniture and  
 effects the same shall be referred to and decided by my Trustees  
 other than my said daughter whose decision shall be  
 final and conclusive I devise all my messuages lands here-  
 ditaments and premises in Walford Street Redditch aforesaid  
 and Gladless Cross Redditch aforesaid (subject to any mortgage  
 or mortgage thereon at the time of my decease) unto my said son  
 absolutely I devise all the residue (if any) of my real estate  
 and bequeath all the residue of my personal estate unto my  
 Trustees Upon trust to call in or sell and convert the same

into money and to pay thereout my debts and my funeral  
and testamentary expenses and to hold the residue thereof  
In trust for my said son absolutely I declare that the  
reason why I have not made further provisions in this my  
Will for my said daughter is that I have provided for her  
in my lifetime And I ~~declare~~<sup>direct</sup> that my Trustee the said  
William George Thomas shall be allowed all professional  
and other charges for his time and trouble which if employed  
as Solicitor to my Trustee not being himself a Trustee he would  
be entitled to make In witness whereof I have to this my  
Will hereunto set my hand this twenty fourth day of February  
One thousand nine hundred and thirteen
