Gertrude Maud Webb of Redditch in the County of Worcester Spinster I appoint my Brothers Edgar Bertie Webb and Wilfred Harold Leonard Webb (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the **Executors** and **Trustees** of this my Will I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my Trustees Upon trust to sell call in and convert into money the same or such part or parts thereof as shall not consist of ready money and with and out of the moneys produced by such sale calling in and conversion and with and out of ready money to pay my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts And to stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys In trust to invest the same in any investments for the time being authorised by law for the investment of trust moneys with power from time to time to vary such investments And to pay the income of the said residuary moneys and of the investments for the time being representing the same (hereinafter called "the residuary trust fund") to my Mother Catherine Webb during her life And upon her decease to pay out of the residuary trust fund the sum of Fifty pounds to each of my three brothers Edgar Bertie Webb Wilfred Harold Leonard Webb and Victor Gordon Webb absolutely And to stand possessed of the remainder of the residuary trust fund and the income thereof In
