This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor of the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.

This is the last Will and Testament

_____ of me _____
 Thomas Edward Webb of Redditch in
 the county of Worcester Baker and Corn Dealer
 I hereby revoke all former testamentary &
 dispositions made by me and declare this to be
 my last Will I appoint my dear wife &
 Catherine Webb and my son Edgar Bertie
 Webb (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the
 Executors and Trustees of my Will I give
 all my plate linen china glass books pictures
 prints wines liquors furniture and other household
 effects to my wife absolutely I devise and
 bequeath all the residue of my personal estate
 and effects and all my real estate unto and to
 the use of my Trustees their heirs executors &
 administrators and assigns Upon trust that my
 Trustees shall sell call in and convert into money
 the said real and personal estate and premises
 with power to postpone such sale and conversion
 for such a period as my Trustees without being
 liable to account may think proper and so that
 any reversionary interest be not sold until it falls
 into possession unless my Trustees see special reason
 for sale And shall out of the nett proceeds of
 such sale calling in and conversion pay my &

funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and the pecuniary legacies bequeathed by any codicil hereto And shall hold the residue of the proceeds of such sale and conversion and money (hereinafter called "the residuary trust fund") Upon the trusts hereinafter declared that is to say Upon trust to invest the same in the purchase of or at interest upon any stocks funds or securities which may for the time being be authorized by law for the investment of trust funds with power from time to time at their discretion to vary alter and transpose all or any of the stocks funds or securities into or for other stocks funds or securities of the same or a like nature And to pay to my said wife or permit her to receive the income of the residuary trust fund during her life And from and after her death shall stand possessed of and interested in the capital and income of the residuary trust fund Upon trust to pay thereout to my said son Edgar Bertie Webb the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds To my daughter Gertrude Maud Webb the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds To my son Victor Gordon Webb the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds And to my daughter Nora Kathleen Webb the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds And to divide the residue of the residuary trust fund among all my children who being sons attain the age of twenty one years or

being daughters attain that age or marry under that age in equal shares and if there shall be only one such child the whole to be in trust for that one child. Provided always that if any child of mine shall die in my lifetime leaving a child or children living at my death who being a son or sons attain the age of twenty one years or being a daughter or daughters attain that age or marry then and in every such case the last mentioned child or children shall take (and if more than one equally between them) the share which his her or their parent would have taken in the residuary trust fund if such parent had survived me and attained the age of twenty one years. **In witness** whereof I have hereunto set my hand this fourteenth day of February one thousand nine hundred and twelve.


