This Grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the War to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject, wherever resident, or to anyone on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey or Bulgaria, of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown, acting through the Treasury; and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.

Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.

# This is the last Will and Testament

of me

Elizabeth Pinfield Wells of The Brewers  
 Inns Inn Redditch in the County of Worcester  
 Widow I appoint my two Sons Edmund Pinfield  
 Wells and Lewis Pinfield Wells (hereinafter  
 called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and  
 Trustees of my Will I devise and bequeath  
 all my real and personal estate unto my Trustees  
 Upon trust that my Trustees shall sell call  
 in and convert into money the same or such  
 part thereof as shall not consist of money and  
 shall out of the moneys produced by such sale  
 calling in and conversion and with and out of  
 my ready money pay my funeral and testamentary  
 expenses and debts And shall invest the residue  
 of the said moneys in any securities for the  
 time being authorised by law for the investment  
 of trust moneys with power for my Trustees from  
 time to time to vary such investments And  
 shall stand possessed of the residue of the  
 said moneys and the investments for the time  
 being representing the same (hereinafter called  
 "the residuary trust fund") In trust until my  
 youngest surviving child shall attain the age of  
 fifteen years or die under that age to use and  
 apply the whole or any part of the income of

the residuary trust fund for the maintenance  
education and support of all my children or any  
my child who shall at my death be under the  
age of fifteen years and also at their discretion  
for the maintenance and support of any of my  
other children who shall be over fifteen years of  
age and under twenty one years who in the  
opinion of my Trustees are unable to properly  
maintain and support themselves himself or herself  
And upon my youngest surviving child attaining  
the age of fifteen years or dying under that age  
my Trustees shall hold the residuary trust fund  
and the income thereof In trust for all my  
children who being sons have attained or shall  
attain the age of twenty one years or being  
daughters have attained or shall attain that age  
or have married or shall marry under that age  
in equal shares and if there shall be only  
one such child the whole to be in trust for  
that child **In witness** whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand this fifteenth day of April  
One thousand nine hundred and thirteen. #


