Upon an application to the Solicitor to the Treasury there will be no difficulty in proper cases in obtaining the sanction of the Treasury to the payment of a moderate sum out of assets to beneficiaries or creditors who are German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subjects resident in this country at the commencement of the War and during the War.

Thins & Sons I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Willis all my property Trade tools and effects for her life At the death of my wife I give all my property Trade tools and effects to my sons John William and Robert Willis for equal rights but my son William Willis to be master and principal I also leave to my daughter Eva Willis ten shillings per week out of the Trade when unable to work I also wish my son William Willis to live at 18 Windsor Street house, Also my daughters to have

work in preference to non-members of the Family
